Dr. Ross is the President and Founder of Reasons to Believe

(www.reasons.org). He leads a team of scholars and academicians to research, study, and then proclaim the most powerful and compelling reasons to believe in God the Creator. His insightful and in depth scientific knowledge, along with his command of up-to-date research and evidence, are effectively communicated to reach skeptics and doubter across the globe. He speaks at seminars such as the upcoming event at New Covenant Academy to equip Christians to engage, rather than withdraw from or blindly retaliate, in discussions with educated non-Christians.

Dr. Ross has a Ph.D. in astrophysics

from the University of Toronto and an undergraduate degree in physics from the University of British Columbia.

Outside of RTB, he teaches as an adjunct faculty member at both A.W. Tozer Seminary and Southern Evangelical Seminary. He has also debated atheists such as Victor Stenger (University of Hawaii) at Cal Tech. So, he's actively engaged in spreading the truth: God is the creator of all things, and science points to His power, presence, and provision.

I am thrilled that Dr. Ross will be at NCA to share his knowledge, expertise, and insight on the latest scientific evidence that point to the Creator of the Universe, the God of the Bible.

We look forward to having you and other guests at NCA on September 9th, 2016, at 7 PM, to learn and grow together.
