Admissions Deadline for New Students

Regular Admissions Deadline

- Application Deadline: January 31
- Notification of Admissions Decision: February 10
- Registration Fee Due: \$2000 within 5 days of admission

Mid-Year Transfers/Admissions

- Application accepted if space is available
- Notification of Admissions Decision: within 10 days of application submission
- Registration Fee: prorated from regular registration fee

Re-enrollment for Current Students

Regular Re-Enrollment Deadline

If completed by January 20: \$2000

Late Registration

If completed after January 20: \$2500

Admissions Check List

All applicants must submit completed online/paper applications.

Kindergarten Applicants

- Copy of child's official birth certificate
- Confidential pre-school recommendation form

Kindergarten applicants are typically assessed for developmental readiness as part of NCA's admissions process. Our Admissions Office will schedule your child's assessment date/time.

Grades 1 - 5 Applicants

- Copy of child's official birth certificate
- Confidential teacher recommendation forms
- Copy of transcript or at least previous 3 years grades

Standardized test scores may be required. If not available, NCA will administer Terra Nova or Stanford 10 assessments. There is a testing fee of \$100. An interview is also required.

Middle and High School Applicants

- Copy of child's official birth certificate
- Confidential teacher recommendation forms
- Confidential counselor or admin rec. forms
- Copy of transcript or at least previous 3 years grades

Standardized test scores may be required. NCA will also administer Terra Nova or Stanford 10 or SAT/ACT assessments. There is a testing fee of \$100, and it may take 3 to 4 hours for full assessment. An interview is also required.

Scholarships

NCA provides generous scholarship to MK's (children of full-time missionaries) who have proven track record and potential for advancement.

Full-time missionaries will need to provide documents such as commissioning organization's verification, ministry records or activities, and other documents deemed required by the admissions office.

ADDITIONAL ITEMS

Lunch

Hot lunches (including beverage, condiments, and utensils) are catered to school each day. A menu is provided to families in advance, and lunch orders can be placed at www.boonli.com. The cost per serving is \$6.50 at the time of publication.

Uniform

NCA students are required to wear school uniforms. Various uniforms for normal wear and PE can be purchased at Dennis Uniform (<http://www.dennisuniform.com>) or at their Los Angeles store.

Other Fees

Parents are responsible for other costs related to sports participation or field trips. The school only requests actual costs of student participation.

Donation

Refund Policy
