NCA's mission statement is to *educate, equip, and enable the Christian leaders of tomorrow* by providing high quality college prep instruction, spiritual guidance, mentoring support, and family-strengthening counseling programs. NCA does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national origin, disability, gender, religion, or income.

UNIQUE FEATURES

- NCA is small by design; the average high school class is 15 students
- NCA does not rank its students
- NCA is one of only four high schools in the city of Los Angeles providing the International Baccalaureate Diploma Program
- NCA offers both AP and IB tracks
- All core classes at the high school level have been approved by the UC system and are on the a-g list
- NCA has developed a high-tech learning environment that utilizes both traditional curriculum as well as Pearson's digital textbooks, content, as well as other learning and assessment features
- 99% of graduates have been accepted by at least one University of California campus
- Graduates have moved on to a variety of top tier universities and liberal arts colleges such as: *Air Force Academy, Cornell, Davidson, Duke, Emory, Haverford, Naval Academy, NYU, UC Berkeley, UCLA, USC, U Penn, Vanderbilt, Wesleyan, West Point, and Yale*
- The Class of 2017, made up of 15 students, collectively earned \$2.1 million in merit-based scholarships, and the Class of 2018, made up of 14 students, collectively earned \$1.5 million in merit-based scholarships
- NCA consistently produces multiple National Merit Semi-Finalists and Commendation Recipients each year
- NCA competes in various sports through the California Interscholastic Federation (CIF), and has won multiple state-wide academic championship awards in Wrestling and Basketball
